Agenda Item No. 2:

Approve the course content of all the existing courses wherein the few revisions have been proposed in view of recent developments in area of different subjects and new courses in specialization of Intellectual Property Law (pg. nos. 22-23, 55-57, 58-59, 60-61, 62-63, 64-66).

Resolve: The draft of contents was approved subject to the following suggestions:

In existing papers, the revisions were approved as suggested.

In IP Laws, the contents of the course codes LL.M. 560, 565, 574, 575, 580 were approved in principle. However, the Board Members suggested that the contents should be rearranged in a manner so as to bring international framework such as conventions, treaties of respective subjects should be followed by national framework.

Besides, the content in each unit should be evenly distributed.

Agenda Item No. 3:

Introducing two new Inter-disciplinary Courses (IDC) introduced by Dr. Raj Kumar Yadav — (LL.M. 519 at Pg. No.75-76) The Making of Indian Constitution and Dr. Ravinder Kaur- (LL.M. 520 at Pg. No.76-78) Consumer Protection Laws.

Resolve: The contents were approved as suggested. However, it was suggested that in the course of Consumer Protection Laws, the suggested readings should be arranged in alphabetical order to maintain uniformity.

Agenda Item No. 4:

Introducing one new Value Added Course (VAC) introduced by Dr. Ravinder Kaur – (LL.M. 603 at Pg. No. 29-30) Indianization of Legal Education.

Resolve:

It was suggested to change the title of the course from 'Indianization of Legal Education' to 'Indic Perspectives of Administration of Justice'. Rest course contents approved as suggested.
