The duration of Chair Professors be for 2-3 years. It further recommended that the budgetary provisions for these Chairs be made in 12th Plan proposal.

The Committee noted the setting up of a Chair in the name of Satguru Ram Singh by the university provided the necessary additional grant for this purpose is received.

The members commended the speedy progress of the University and the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

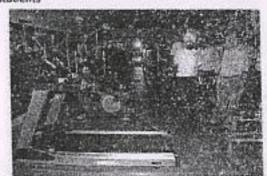

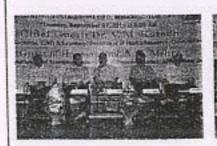

- Further as per the directions from UGC during the 12th Plan each central University, has to set up 20 constituent colleges in the state. <u>Keeping in view of this, each constituent college</u> would require 50 crores in the 12th plan, i.e. an additional amount of Rs. 1000 crores.
