As per the requirement of NAAC, Student Satisfaction Survey is required to be conducted every year. SSS for the session 2018-19 was conducted on May 24, 2019. The response of 350 students was received and the result has been analyzed and presented below:

One open ended question was asked from the students. The responses given by majority of the students have been mentioned below:

## 21. Give three observation / suggestions to improve the overall teaching and learning experience in your institution.

- 1. Students should be taken to field visit regarding their respective subjects to learn new things in practical manner.
- 2. Internship should be must as to acquire knowledge.
- 3. Student teacher interaction, placement cell, digitalization of lectures
- 4. Team project work should be employed on second semester.
- 5. A group discussion on major topics of society can encourage student's interest & activity.
- 6. Assignments should be discussed in classes.
- 7. We need to get more exposure to the lab instruments and our syllabus should be made like that we could more focus on practical rather than theory part.
- 8. There should be focus on main syllabus as it will ultimately lead to success in competitive examination.
- 9. Recent studies should be given by teachers.
- 10. Teachers have to promote students in carrier oriented schemes and also have to counsel students.
- 11. More focus is needed in one-one interaction between mentor and student.
- 12. Some teachers are biased and sometimes demotivate by their words or assessment, this should be taken care of.
- 13. Teachers should come on time to attend classes.
- 14. More focus on applications of topics and subject in problem solving
- 15. Guest interaction lectures and exchange programs with other good universities be initiated.
- 16. Conduction of assignments and term paper should be improved because due to lack of proper conduction student take it as paper work only and wants to just submit before deadline irrespective of gaining knowledge.
- 17. Should focus on promoting internship and field visit.
- 18. They need to tell us about employability skills.

- 19. There should be proper experimental studies, with having all instruments in the laboratory.
- 20. Teachers should be punctual and properly prepare their lectures
- 21. Need to give full exposure to children about scientific skills.
- 22. Practical need to be conducted more carefully and with planning, not many students actually get to perform and learn them. We don't have enough kits or raw material so that everyone can perform the practical.
- 23. Exchange programs, study tours, support and motivation to attend seminar and conference
- 24. Kindly make the teacher accountable to the students not vice chancellor or person sitting in the senior position.
- 25. The teachers should not be biased, they should take into consider the individual difference of the students and they must help the students when they need them
- 26. Interaction between students and teachers should be more.
- 27. Formation and regular function of various co-curricular activities clubs like Music Club, Art and drawing spot, innovative writing club, regular Patriotic and cultural get together, National problems analysis club, etc.
- 28. Regular carrier guidance to the current students by teachers and alumni. So, "Annual alumni meet" can be organized.
- 29. University Clubs should be encouraged not for just name sake but for active participation which will enable the students to enrich their knowledge in their areas of interest.
- 30. Teaching foreign languages and soft skills in Interdisciplinary Course system would be advantageous.
- 31. There is a need of improvement in technical section because I observed that after completing course we do not have any detail mark card of single semester. We have no proof of master degree from central university Punjab, Bathinda.
- 32. There is no statistics Lab with known software SPSS, SAS, Minitab etc. So, Need of statistical Lab with software and trainer.
- 33. Geology is field based subject so at least one field work per semester should be
- 34. Remedial classes are not available.
- 35. Although the syllabus is based on CSIR- NET JRF but we could hardly practice the questions based in the exam.
