## Report on analysis of Feedback on curriculum received from Faculty Members

To get the feedback on the curriculum of different programmes, a google form was sent to all faculty members. Their information was analyzed. The report of the analysis of feedback of curriculum by them is given below:

- 1. 87% of the faculty members agreed that the curriculum was as per the need of the students.
- 2. 88% consented that the contents of the course had been presented from simple to complex form.
- 3. 88% of the faculty members agreed that the curriculum provides opportunity for the conducting research and projects related activities.
- 4. 86% accepted the fact that the contents of the course were in conformity with the learning outcomes.
- 5. 85% were satisfied that the curriculum was balanced with regard to the theoretical and practical knowledge.
- 6. 86% have consented on the statement that Pedagogy proposed in the curriculum matches the contents.
- 7. 90% of the faculty members think that the contents of the curriculum were in tune with the UGC-NET/CSIR examinations.
- 8. 85% agreed upon the fact that the curriculum had the potential in developing the habit of self-learning among the students.
- 9. 69% of the faculty members gave comments that the curriculum development procedure needs improvement.
- 10. 82% of the faculty members have complied with the fact that the learning outcomes of the curriculum are of global standard.
- 11. 80% agreed that the curriculum has focus on skill development.
- 12. 85% of the faculty have agreed that the opinion of the faculty members were taken in to account during curriculum revision.
- 13. 55% faculty members have given their consent that the presence of student representative in the curriculum has no value.
- 14. 63% of the faculty members consented on the fact that the evaluation of the course was appropriate to discriminate the students.

Some points, for improving curriculum, suggested by the faculty members are given below:

1. Curriculum is excellent but Examination system needs to be changed. End Term Examination should be of 3 Hours duration and have 50%

- contribution. Project should be graded and marks obtained added in CGPA.
- 2. The curriculum is required to be improved every year in line with the recent developments in the subject so that the global competency of our students will enhance.
- 3. Modifications with relevance to global scenarios, involvement of case studies, simulations will add more value to course.
- 4. There is much burden on the students and faculty as well.
- 5. Level of curriculum needs to be raised to meet the global standards.
- 6. The first Unit on Development can be reduced and more content on Development Communication can be added
- 7. Some of the topics from the first semester of Course titled Reporting for Print Media are repeated in the syllabus. The repetition can be deleted.
