## Report Curriculum Audit-2023

The curriculum audit of 31 departments was conducted on 25th and 26th May, 2023 as per the schedule (Annexure-I) and a structured criterion was followed (Annexure II). The departments were grouped and the following members of the committee reviewed the curriculum:

The general guidelines based on National Credit Framework (NCrF) was given to the department for necessary action:

- 1. Template for uniform course and credit distribution was shared.
- The total credits for all the PG programs shall be 80-85 credits with uniform framework throughout the university.
- IDC and VAC shall be offered in second and third semesters respectively.
- 4. The Discipline enrichment course which was proposed with an objective to guide the students for national level competitive examination will be removed as the students are already getting such guidancethrough competitive examination cell and discipline specific syllabus is covered in the core courses.
- The Entrepreneurship course with a focus on Innovation, Skill development, and Entrepreneurship in specific disciplines will be of 2 credits.
- 6. One non-credit hour (two contact hours) for Individualized Education Plan/tutorial to be added for remedial teaching to cater to the learning needs of all the learners. Objective of this class is to facilitate the students to understand the concepts better, absorb and assimilate the content more effectively during extra hours. Two hours per week will be assigned and be marked in the time table. The teachers will distribute the time as per the courses they are taking during that semester.

- For the experiential learning/internship, 01 credit is equivalent to 40-45 contact hours as per NCrF guidelines.
- UGC guidelines will be followed for Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit for all the Master's programmes.
- The curriculum feedback from the stakeholders and exit survey was shared with the respective departments for necessary action.
