- To deliberate the panel of external examiners for evaluation of Dissertation of Economics The meeting after detailed deliberations resolved with the following for consideration of School Board
 - Programme structure and syllabus of M.A. (Economics) is being recommended with the following additions/deletions/modifications
 - Inclusion of new value based course for post graduate students of the university i.e. Data for Research in Economics (ECO.535)
 - Inclusion of new elective courses for post graduate students of the university i.e.

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Economics of Education (ECO.518), Economics of Healthcare Policy(ECO.563)

Inclusion of Central tendency and dispersion in Unit one in the course i.e Statistical Methods for Economics (ECO.523)

Addition of Recent Policy Changes in monetary policy in the course Money and Banking (ECO.525)

The percentage of curriculum updation for M. A. Economics is 5-7 percent.

Programme structure and syllabus of Ph.D. (Economics) is being approved with the following additions/deletions/modifications:

Inclusion of new elective courses for Ph.D students of the university i.e. Economics of Education and Development (ECO.710) Agrarian Change and Policy (ECO.711)

Title of Unit one is to be replaced by the theories of economics of education in the course of Economics of Education and Development (ECO.710)

Crop Insurance is to be added in unit II in course of Agrarian Change and Policy (ECO.711)

The percentage of curriculum updation for M.A. Economics is 10-12 percent.

3. The committee members discuss that the establishment of Economics Lab is urgently required for practice of the courses introduced in the syllabus. The members recommend the establishment of economics lab in the department and suggested that in the beginning it may establish with 10 PCs and may be expanded later as per the utilization (Annexure – A).
