Guidelines/Instructions for students regarding Convocation

Convocation of the University is a very important and solemn occasion. All Concerned (Particularly students) are therefore requested to maintain proper decorum in keeping the dignity of the occasion. Following are some of the guidelines/instructions in this regard:

- The 8th Convocation of Central University of Punjab, Bathinda shall be held on 12th April, 2023 at 11 AM. Venue: Monument Lawn (opposite to Aryabhata Academic Block), Central University of Punjab, Village- Ghudda, Bathinda.
- All the Students of PG (Batch- 2020) & Ph.D. who passed out in 2022 & 2023 will be admitted to the degree at this Convocation.
- All the Students are required to attend positively the rehearsals of the Convocation, first rehearsal sum attendance shall be held on 11.04.2023 evening and second full dress rehearsal cum attendance on 12.04.2023 at 9:00 AM. Attending of both rehearsals will be mandatory, otherwise they will not be allowed to attend the Convocation ceremony.
- On 12.04.2023 students will have to sit on their assigned seats only, after the start
 of Convocation, nobody will be allowed to leave the Convocation hall.
- Students are required to bring the system/online generated registration slip for entry in Convocation hall, otherwise they will not be allowed to attend the Convocation ceremony.
- The Convocation stole shall be supplied by the Examinations Branch on 11th April, 2023 from 12:00 Noon to 2:00 PM.
- Degree certificate will be distributed in the Convocation Hall on the day of convocation ceremony, Students who want the Degree in-absentia, their Degrees will be forwarded to them through Registered/Speed Post.
- The students attending the Convocation are required to make their own arrangement of stay. No accommodation will be provided by the University to the students who will come to attend the Convocation.
- Complete silence is to be observed during the entire proceeding.
