



## Competition to Create Awareness about the Legal Rights of Women

**Date: 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018**

The Central University of Punjab, Bathinda is organizing a competition on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018 funded by National Commission for Women, New Delhi. It is based on the guidelines provided by Commission to create awareness among the University student community about the legal rights of women.

### Instructions for the Competition:

1. The competition shall open to all students of CUPB irrespective of their gender.
2. Registration for participants is free but compulsory through online registration.
3. There will be 100 MCQs having four options each to be completed in 01 hour & 15 minutes
4. Each correct answer for a question stands for 01 mark and there will be negative marking (1/4) for each wrong answer.
5. Test will be conducted online where each participant will be given a registration number and password.
6. In case of more than one candidate for a position/prize then the time taken for completion of test will be considered.
7. Participation certificate will be given to all the participants. However, cash prizes will be given to the winners only.

**Cash Prize: First Prize (One): 2000/-**  
**Second Prize (One): 1,500/-**  
**Third Prize (Five): 1000 X 5 = 5000/-**

8. The students may be tested in respect of provisions of the Constitution and laws relating to women's rights and empowerment. The competition may, include topics relating to the following laws:
  - (i) Constitution of India mainly, the Preamble, Fundamental Rights, Directive Principles of State Policy, Fundamental Duties, including Article 33 and Article 226 thereof.
  - (ii) National Commission for Women Act, 1990 (20 of 1990)
  - (iii) Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961
  - (iv) Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005
  - (v) The Sexual Harassment of Women at Work place (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal Act) Act, 2013
  - (vi) The Criminal Law Amendment Act, 2013
  - (vii) The Maternity Benefit Act, 1961
  - (viii) The Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 (34 of 1971)
  - (ix) The Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956
  - (x) The Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) Act, 1994
  - (xi) The Minimum Wages Act, 1948
  - (xii) SC and the ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Amendment Act, 2015

(xiii) The Scheduled Tribes and other traditional forest dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2008
