Consideration:


- Item no. 001: The Dean of the School informed that the Competent Authority has instructed to expedite the submission of result. It was appraised that total 10 students who have submitted their draft of dissertation, and the Examiners have evaluated the drafts and conveyed their availability on Saturday for Viva-vice. Their viva-voce is scheduled on 17 July 2021. The same has already intimated to all supervisors and students;
- Item no. 002: Regarding the syllabus of different courses of 2nd Semester, it was informed that almost all topics have been covered in 'Judicial Process' and 'Comparative Public Law and Governance'. Regarding the syllabus of 'Interpretation of


Statutes', Dr. Deepak Kumar had already informed before proceeding on duty leave (field survey) that the syllabus was almost complete. Dr. Sukhwinder Kaur informed that one unit of Applied Legal Studies- I and II (each) is pending as she resumed her duty on 15 June 2021 after availing maternity leave earlier this course was being taught by Guest Faculty. Dr. Sukhwinder Kaur assured that she will complete the remaining syllabus at the end of July, 2021.


Item no. 003: As advised by the Competent Authority to invite specialization from students of 2nd Semester, LL.M. Course, the Faculty Members appreciated this advised and shared that it has already been discussed and appraised to the student in the beginning of this Academic Session 2020-22 that with the existing strength, only two specializations will be offered i.e. **Environmental Law and Human Rights Law.**

Item.no. 004: Regarding subjects allocations, for the time being, the faculty members Dr. Puneet Pathak and Dr. Sukhwinder Kaur shared that they will teach in area of Human Rights Law, while Dr. Tarun Arora is in teaching of Environmental Law with Dr. Deepak Kumar and same shall be continued as in existence.

Item. no. 005 As advised by Competent Authority regarding allotment of supervisor which should be allotted to students at the end of II semester, the same was appreciated by faculty members. The office of HoD do the needful in this regard. Faculty members also suggested that supervisor may be allotted at the beginning of II semester. So that they may be associated with the students of IV semester for peer learning and assistantship.
