


Respected Sir,


1. Accommodation for the experts in University Guest House on 29th and 30th September 2015;



The Committee unanimously resolved to adopt the course structure, syllabus and course of reading of M.A. in History, Political Science and M.Phil (South and Central Asian Studies)



Minutes of School Board Meeting of School Board of Global Relation
held on 10 December, 2015

The meeting of School Board of School of Global Relation was held on 10 December 2015 at 10.30am in the Conference Hall of Administrative Block, CUPB. The following members were present in the meeting:-

The committee thoroughly discussed the points of agenda to get approval of M.A in History, M.A in Political Science and M. Phil in SCA programmes, offered by Centre for South and Central Asian Studies (Including Historical Studies). After discussion the following decisions were taken:

1. The Board discussed the Course structure and Syllabus of Master of Arts in History. The courses are - HST. 501, HST.503, HST.504, HST.505, HST. HST. 599, HST. 511, HST. 522, (1st Semester); HST. 502, HST. 526, HST.527, HST.528, HST.599, HST. 536, HST. 546 (2nd Semester); HST.601, HST. 602, HST.600, HST.621, HST.622 (3rd Semester) and HST.626, HST.627, HST. 600, HST.646, HST.647 (4th Semester). After discussing the same, some punctuation and grammar related mistakes were marked out by the members. The Board has suggested for proof reading and making changes in reading lists in such a way as essential, additional, articles from journals, and websites. Observations and suggestions made by the School Board members were noted down by Dr. Vinay Kumar Rao and he is directed to make the changes suggested by the School Board and submit it latest by 5 January 2016.
2. The School Board accepted the new Syllabus of HST. 501, Research Methodology as per the suggestions given by the BOS.
3. The Board discussed the Course structure and Syllabus of Master of Arts (MA) in Political Science and suggested the following changes:-
 - PSC. 501- No major changes are suggested
 - PSC.503- Concepts in 2nd Unit, Reframing
 - PSC. 504-Inclusion of Gramsci; Book list
 - PSC.505- Inclusion of Unitary Federal debate, Reframing; Grammatical mistake
 - PSC. 511- Reframing of Unit III and inclusion of Afro-Asian struggle, book List

PSC. 626-Unit I Asian financial architecture and emerging economies addition, Unit II addition of specialized agencies; Unit III only two major regional organizations should be taken; Unit IV International non- governmental organizations should be added

PSC. 627- Unit II addition of International sea bed authority

PSC. 646- Two more Units addition and make it more inclusive;

PSC. 647- Unit IV added dark side of Globalization.

After discussing the same, the above-mentioned changes in respective of the course were noted down by Dr. Nishtha Kaushiki (Semester I and II) and Dr. Sudheer Singh Verma (semester III and IV). Both are directed to incorporate the changes in the respective course and submit it latest by 5 January 2016.

4. The School Board has suggested for removing extra credits devoted to the dissertation in the semester III in M.A in Political Science and creates three more courses having equal credits.
5. The School Board has suggested for mentioning course objectives for all the courses and arranges reading lists in more systematic manner.
6. The School Board has discussed the Course structure and Syllabus of Master of Philosophy in South and Central Asian Studies. After the discussion of the syllabus, the Board has suggested minor reframing in the courses and providing comprehensive and updated reading lists.

The changes suggested by the Board were noted down by Dr. Bawa Singh. He is directed to incorporate the changes in the courses and submit it latest by 5 January 2016.

Concluding the School Board meeting of Global Relations, the Chairperson thanked all the members present in the meeting, especially to Professor S. D. Muni and Professor
