At the outset the Chairperson welcomed all the members of the School Board, School of Social Sciences and requested Prof. P. K. Mishra, Associate Dean, School of Social Sciences to present the agenda. The committee discussed and deliberated on the following Agenda items:

1. Recommendation of the curricula of M.A. in Economics, Sociology, History and Psychology to Academic Council.
2. Recommendation of the curricula of Ph.D. Coursework in Economics, Sociology and History to Academic Council.

The Proceedings of the School Board is as under:

1. It is resolved to accept the suggestions made for the improvement of the course contents of various courses of M.A. in Economics & Ph.D. coursework in Economics by Board of Studies with the following additions:
 - (i) In the Research Methodology course, one specific section/module be added covering the theoretical aspects of research methods especially used in different perspectives, both in Master's and Ph.D. levels.

(ii) In the Agricultural Economics course, the concepts such as water scarcity, impact of climate change, and principles of cooperative be added.

(iii) In the Economics of Growth and Development, the original writings of Classical Economists and others be added in the reading list.

(iv) In the Money and Banking course, the Gurley & Shaw and Radcliff approaches to money supply be added.

(v) The latest readings be added in the list in the courses including Indian Economy, Punjab Economy, Environmental Economics, Political economy of Development, and Economics of Growth and Development.

(vi) All the reading list in all the courses be arranged in APA style.

2. It is resolved to accept the suggestions made for the improvement of the course contents of various courses of M.A. in Sociology & Ph.D. coursework in Sociology by Board of Studies with the following change(s):

(i) In place of the course Muslims and India, a course in the nomenclature 'Minorities in India' be introduced.

(ii) In future, the Department should work to introduce a course may be titled 'Punjab Society'.

3. It is resolved that the suggestions made for the revision of the course contents of various courses of M.A. (History) & Ph.D. coursework in History by Board of Studies are alright, and their incorporations are duly accepted by the School Board. In addition, the School Board suggested for focusing more on World History at the Masters level.

4. It is resolved to accept the suggestions made for the improvement of the course contents of various courses of M.A. in Psychology by Board of Studies with the following changes:

(i) In the course PSY.511, the repetitions in Unit-I and II be removed and focus should be given on ethics in research.

(ii) In the course PSY.552, EPQ be included.

(iii) In the course PSY.579, the history of sports psychology in India be included.

(iv) In the course PSY.504 & PSY.512 references be updated in the reading list.

(v) Field study and training in specific Institutes be included in PSY.591.

(vi) The topic of Abnormal Psychology be included.

5. After inclusion of the above suggestions, the School Board recommends and forwards the curricula of M.A. Economics, M.A. Sociology, M.A. History, and M.A. Psychology for necessary approval by the Academic Council in its forthcoming meeting.
6. The School Board recommends and forwards the curricula of the coursework for Ph.D. Economics, Sociology and History for necessary approval by the Academic Council in its forthcoming meeting.
