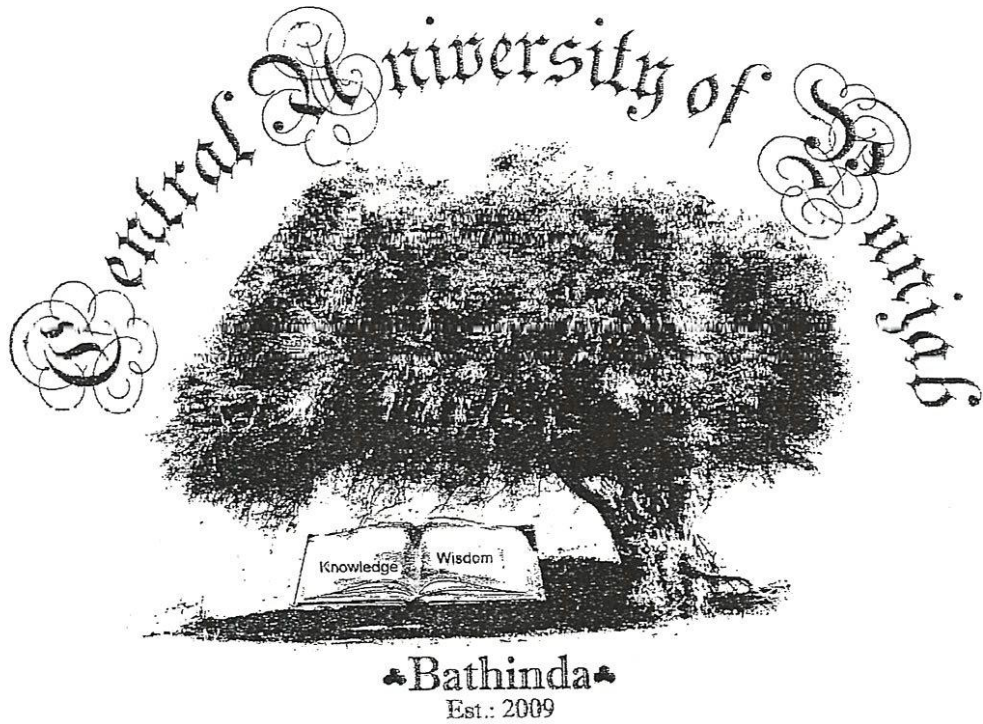

The Vice Chancellor (*Chairman*) welcomed the hon'ble members to the Eighth Meeting of the Executive Council. He thanked all the members for sparing their valuable time from their busy schedule to participate in the meeting. He apprised the Council that as the term of first Executive Council is ending on 29th July 2012, today's meeting is the last official meeting of the Council. He informed that he has requested MHRD to increase the term of the present Executive Council for one more year.

Item No. EC:8:2012:1

To confirm the minutes of the Seventh Meeting of the Executive Council held on 30th June 2012.

The minutes of the Seventh meeting were circulated at a very short notice as the previous meeting was held only a fortnight ago. However, no comments had been received.

The Council confirmed the minutes of the Seventh Meeting of the Executive Council held on 30th June 2012.

The Council approved the Actions Taken on the decisions of the Executive Council in its Seventh Meeting held on 30th June 2012. (*Annexure-1*)

Item No. EC:8:2012:3

To note the report of Vice Chancellor on the progress of university since last meeting of the Executive Council.

The Vice Chancellor briefed the members of the Council about the fourth entrance examination successfully conducted by the university at nine centres across India for admission to 20 courses for academic session 2012-2013.

The members were informed of the details as per *Annexure-2*, which were noted and approved.

Item No. EC:8:2012:4

To consider the adoption of Regulations on "Work Load" of teachers as per UGC Notification till the university frames its own Ordinances. (*Annexure 2 of Agenda*)

The Council approved the adoption of the Regulations on "Work Load" of teachers as specified in UGC Regulations at Section 15 (15.1 to 15.2) of the "UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in University and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010" till the University prepares its Ordinance on "Conditions of Service of Teachers of the University".

The Council further recommended that the University while framing its own Ordinances should lay due emphasis on the development of research culture and ethics amongst the faculty.

Item No. EC:8:2012:5

To consider the adoption of "Code of Professional Ethics" for the teachers as per UGC Notification till the university frames its own Ordinances. (*Annexure 3 of Agenda*)

The Council approved the adoption of the Regulations on "Professional Ethics" for teachers as specified in UGC Regulations at Section 17 (I) to 17 (VII) of the "UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in University and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2010" till the University prepares its Ordinance on "Conditions of Service of Teachers of the University".

Item No. EC:8:2012:6

To consider the recommendations of the Ordinances Committee, constituted by Executive Council (vide Item No. EC:1:2009:3) and Academic Council (vide Item No. AC:1:2009:3) for approving eight ordinances finalized by this Committee in its meeting held on 10th July 2012. (*Annexure-4 of Agenda*)

The Council approved the Ordinance pertaining to Building Advisory Committee (*Annexure-3*) and further recommended that the other seven Ordinances may be first placed before the Academic Council in its forthcoming meeting and approval of the Executive Council be then obtained through circulation.

Item No. EC:8:2012:7

To consider the proceedings of the Building Advisory Committee regarding the selection of the Project Management Consultant (PMC) for the Phase - I construction works of the main campus.

The Council approved the recommendations of the Building Advisory Committee regarding the selection of M/s Engineers India Limited (EIL), New Delhi as the Project Management Consultants for Phase-I construction works of the University (*Annexure-5 of Agenda, enclosed as Annexure-4*).

Item No. EC:8:2012:8

To consider the proceedings of the Building Advisory Committee regarding the selection of the Architect for the Phase - I works of the main campus.

The Council approved the recommendations of the Building Advisory Committee (*Annexure 6 of Agenda, enclosed as Annexure-5*) regarding the selection of M/s C. P. Kukreja Associates, New Delhi as the Architects for preparing the Master Plan of the main campus of the University and noted that this firm has also been shortlisted for Architectural Design and Detailed Engineering Services for the main campus for which the final negotiations are yet to be held and authorised the Vice Chancellor for these.

Item No. EC:8:2012:9

To consider the period for validity of the proceedings of the Selection Committees for selection of regular teaching and non-teaching positions in case of wait-listed or empanelled candidates.

The Council deliberated on the matter in detail and resolved that the panel recommended by the Selection Committees for the selection of regular teaching and non-teaching positions be considered valid for a period of one year from the date of interviews. It also resolved that instead of preparing a waiting list, a panel in order of merit be prepared.

Item No. EC:8:2012:10

To consider extension in services of S. Gurtej Singh Sra as University Engineer

The Council approved the extension of the contractual appointment of University Engineer S. Gurtej Singh Sra, on consolidated emoluments of Rs. 70,000/- per month for one year or till the post is filled up on regular basis, whichever is earlier.

To consider the status of admissions in various courses for the year 2012-2013.

The Council noted the response of applicants for various courses offered by the University for the academic session 2012-2013 (*Annexure-6*). The Council opined that where the number of eligible

candidates for admission is less than ten, those courses may not be started. It further suggested that opinion of the Academic Council be also obtained on this matter.

Fixing date of the next meeting of the Executive Council.


The Council authorized the Vice Chancellor to fix the date for the next meeting of the Council.

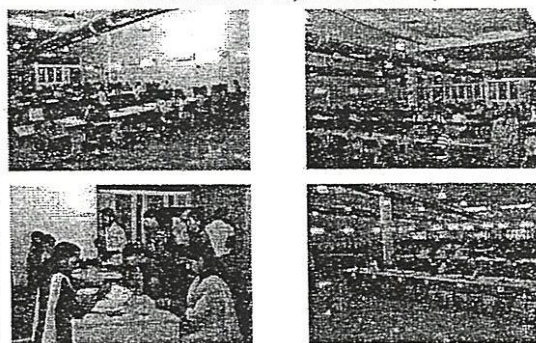

Ordinance-XXXVII

BUILDING ADVISORY COMMITTEE
(Act Section 28(1) (j))

1. Constitution

There shall be a Building Advisory Committee of the University.

2. Composition

The composition of the Building Advisory Committee shall be as follows:

2.1	Vice Chancellor	Chairperson (Ex-officio)
2.2	Pro-Vice Chancellor	
2.3	A representative of the CPWD or PWD not below the rank of Executive Engineer	Member
2.4	A representative of Planning Board nominated by Vice Chancellor	Member
2.5	A representative of user Centre/Unit	Member
2.6	Two teachers of the University not below the rank of Professor nominated by Vice Chancellor	Members
2.7	Principal of engineering college in the University or from a nearby University	Member (Ex-officio)
2.8	University Engineer and/or University Architect and/or a Government Architect	Member (Ex-officio)
2.9	Finance Officer	Member (Ex-officio)
2.10	Registrar	Member Secretary (Ex-officio)

NOTE : 1. The Dean of the School/the Coordinator of the Centre, who shall be the main utilizer of the proposed Building Project be invited to attend the meeting, in which the said project comes up for consideration.
2. Additional expert members and/or representatives of EC, AC or FC may also be invited by the Vice Chancellor.

3. Term of Office

The term of office of the members, other than ex-officio, shall be one year.

4. Quorum

One third members shall form a quorum.

5. Functions

The Committee shall:

- 5.1 be responsible for finalizing the plans and estimates of the various Building Projects proposed to the UGC, the Ministry of Human Resource Development or to the Government of India or any other funding Agency, in accordance with the approved plans and estimates;
- 5.2 be responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the University buildings;
- 5.3 assess the cost of repairs, additions, alteration and demolition of the University buildings annually and prepare the Budget for the same to be submitted for approval of the Finance Committee/Executive Council;
- 5.4 exercise all such powers, as delegated to it by the Executive Council from time to time; and
- 5.5 constitute one or more Sub Committee (s) to look after any of the functions and responsibilities assigned to it.

6. Meetings

The Committee shall meet at least twice in a year, or as and when necessary.

Proceedings of the Building Advisory Committee Meeting held at Bhai Vir Singh Sahitva Sadan, New Delhi on 10th July 2012 for finalization of the Project Management Consultant for Phase - I works of the Central University of Punjab to be built at main campus at Ghudda, Distt Bathinda

1. The Building Advisory Committee meeting was held on 10th July 2012 to finalise the Project Management Consultant for the Phase I work of the main campus.
2. The following four Government organisations were called to give presentation to the Building Advisory Committee and for opening of the Financial bids after evaluating the Technical bids of the following firms:
 - (a) M/s BSNL
 - (b) M/s EdCIL Ltd
 - (c) M/s EIL
 - (d) M/s RITES Ltd.
3. All the above organisations made detailed presentations highlighting the technical issues. The Building Advisory Committee carried out the technical evaluation of the four organizations. M/s BSNL and M/s EdCIL do not have enough experience, turnover and infrastructure to carry out the PMC of educational institutions construction work and the committee unanimously shortlisted the following two organizations for considering their financial bids:
 - (a) M/s EIL, New Delhi
 - (b) M/s RITES, Gurgaon
4. The financial bids of the above mentioned firms were accordingly opened in the presence of the representatives of the firms. M/s EIL, New Delhi had attached terms and conditions alongwith the financial bid which were withdrawn by the firm as recorded on the financial bid document. The comparative statement of the financial bids is as under:-

Sr. No.	Name of the Firm	Fee for Project Management Consultancy services
(a)	M/s EIL	3% of the project cost excluding service tax + cess as applicable from time to time.
(b)	M/s RITES Limited	4.8 % of the project cost excluding service tax on the fee quoted at the rates as stipulated by Govt. of India from time to time presently payable at 12.36% on fee.
5. M/s RITES limited were also called and enquired if they would like to work @ 3% the rate quoted by L1 M/s EIL Ltd, however, Mr Y. K. Sharma, G. M. of M/s RITES declined to work @ 3% of the project cost.
6. The Committee recommends that M/s EIL be engaged for the Project Management Consultancy services for Phase - I of the main buildings of the Central University of Punjab to be built at main campus at Ghudda, Distt Bathinda at the rate of 3% of the project cost excluding service tax + cess as applicable from time to time. The final agreement including detailed terms and

conditions to be signed with the organization should be finalized by a committee of three experts to be appointed by the Vice Chancellor.
