About ITEP

The ITEP is of four years duration across eight semesters of study. It is a dual-major bachelor's degree programme, with one major in Education and the other in a disciplinary/interdisciplinary branch of knowledge. In addition, the programme seeks to develop among student-teachers an ethic of social engagement, and capacities such as problem solving, critical thinking, creative thinking, communication skills, ethical and moral reasoning etc. that are necessary for preparing competent teachers. The ITEP seeks to create a pool of competent teachers capable of designing developmentally appropriate teachinglearning-assessment practices that are responsive to the learning needs and interests of children at different stages of their development.

Eligibility

- Candidates with minimum 50% marks in Senior Secondary or plus two examination or its equivalent (under 5+3+3+4 pattern) from a recognised board are eligible for admission.
- The relaxation in percentage of marks in the Senior Secondary or plus two examination or its equivalent examination (under 5+3+3+4 pattern) and in the reservation for Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe or Other Backward Class or Persons with Disabilities or Economically Weaker Section and any other categories shall be as per the rules of the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Administration, wherever applicable.

Multiple Entry and Exit, and Re-entry Options

The ITEP has the provision of multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications.

Student-teachers who wish to exit after completion of one year (two semesters) of study will be given a Certificate indicating the credits accrued for the courses pursued.

- Student-teachers who wish to exit after completion of two years (four semesters) will be given a Diploma indicating the credits accrued for the courses completed.
- Student-teachers who wish to exit after successful completion of three years (six semesters) will be awarded a Bachelor's Degree in the chosen Major area of study upon securing a minimum of 120 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirements of 48 credits for the Major.
- Student-teachers who successfully complete four years (eight semesters) of study will be awarded a dual-major bachelor's degree such as B.A.B.Ed. or B.Sc.B.Ed. Upon securing a minimum of 160 credits, including a minimum of 80 credits for the first major (i.e. in education), and a minimum of 48 credits for the second major (i.e., in a disciplinary/interdisciplinary area relating to one of the curricular areas in school education).

Features of ITEP

- A curriculum with strong integration of theory with practice.
- A curriculum giving opportunity for dual degree.
- Sufficient opportunities for student-teachers to engage deeply with educational ideas and to connect with society and its ethical moorings
- School experience and internships as the most significant components of the ITEP curriculum which offer student-teachers a platform for connecting theory to real-world situations
- Opportunity for full-time engagement in a school to get extensive experience in planning teaching-learning-assessment activities, participating in various school activities.
- Sufficient opportunities to student-teachers during their internship to interact with teachers, students, school/educational administrators, and the community, including parents and other caregivers of children
- Learning activities and experiences that enable student-teachers to recognize India's diversity.
- Opportunity to learn about innovative pedagogies and assessment techniques.
