The last date to receive the nominations was 19.2.2026. The University received five nominations by the due date.

A meeting of the above said Committee was held on 23.02.2026 to discuss the nominations to confer the *Honoris Causa Doctorate*.

2	Dr. Gurdas Maan	Extraordinary contributions to music, culture and global dissemination of Punjabi folk traditions for over four decades. He has won National film award for best actor and best playback singer.
3	Dr. Pushvinder Jit Singh	Significant contribution in promoting startup ecosystem in Punjab and developing industry academia collaboration. M/s Engineers India Limited (EIL) for providing technical support in defending the arbitration matter between Central University of Punjab and KSMB & Sons, in relation to Phase 1A and 1B of the construction project executed by M/s Engineers India Limited (EIL) as the Project Management consultant (PMC) for the Construction of buildings at the Central University of Punjab.	arbitration. 2. The Committee resolved to approve that as per conditions of Agreement University will reimburse the actual cost incurred on the Arbitration case. 3. The Committee approved the arbitration panel constituted by the University and recommended to appoint the sole arbitrator as selected by the contractor from the panel given by the University. <i>The Committee directed the University that, as per the conditions of the contract, EIL should defend the Arbitration on behalf of the University”.</i> In the matter of the Arbitration between CU Punjab (through EIL) and M/s KSMB, the University officials visited the office of M/s Engineers India Limited (EIL) at New Delhi on 22.12.2025. The meeting was held with the Mr. S. Balakumar, Director (Projects), Mr. D.S.N. Murthy, Executive Director and Senior Project Manager (Mr. D. Mitra) from M/s EIL. During the meeting, the modulus of defending the arbitration case was deliberated in detail with the EIL officials and it was decided that EIL will provide technical support and the Legal Support to defend the Arbitration. However, the expenses of Rs. 40,056 plus GST per man-day will be charged by the EIL and in addition to EIL fees, the legal fee will be additional and which will be based on the selection of legal counsel by the University i.e. Junior Advocate/ Advocate/Senior Advocate level. The University vide its letter No. CUPB/RO/2025-26/0093 dated 15.01.2026 (Annexure-71.29) communicated its consent to accept the terms of EIL and sought for the details of the legal fees and the tentative man-days to be deployed for defending the arbitration. In response to the University’s letter dated 15.01.2026, EIL sent a letter dated 06.02.2026 (Annexure-71.30) wherein, EIL informed that they could not provide the technical services until University releases their complete pending payments and issue a separate Work Order for providing technical services for defending the arbitration. Further, in contradiction to the discussion of the meeting, EIL in its letter denied to provide legal services even after the University’s consent to bear the Legal expenses. As per the Procedural Orders, the reply to the claims of arbitration of Phase 1A & Phase 1B were needs to be submitted to the Arbitrator on or before 02.05.2026 & 08.05.2026 respectively. In the absence of the Legal Counsel, the university will not be in position to finalize the reply of the claims of KSM Bashir Mohd. & Sons. In the view of the above circumstances, wherein EIL has denied to
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appoint the Legal Counsel therefore the legal Counsel may be appointed directly by the University, as the Legal expenses are to be borne by the University in either of the case.

The approximation of the exact cost of legal services at this stage is not possible as the legal expenses will depend upon the number of hearings to be done by the Arbitrator separately in both the cases and also the level of Legal counsel to be appointed by the University. The payment of Arbitration including Arbitrator fees, EIL fees for technical support and legal fees may be allowed to be done from the HEFA Loan sanctioned for the project.

Therefore, it was proposed that;

- a) A legal counsel having an experience of the arbitration cases may be appointed directly by the University.
- b) A separate work order for providing the technical support may be issued to EIL for Rs. 40,056/- plus GST per man-day.
- c) All the administrative, technical and legal expenses may be met from the HEFA loan sanction for the above projects.

The matter was placed before the Finance Committee in its 39th meeting held on 09.04.2026 vide **item no. FC:39:2026:3 (Annexure-71.31)** and the following was resolved:

“The Finance Committee, while considering the agenda item, noted the comments received from the Integrated Finance Division, Ministry of Education, with respect to agenda Item No. FC:39:2026:3, wherein it was stated that the HEFA loan has been sanctioned specifically for construction projects and should not be utilized for meeting administrative, technical, and legal expenses.

However, after detailed deliberations, it was unanimously resolved by the committee to approve that, since the arbitration expenses are intrinsically related to the construction of projects under Phase 1A and Phase 1B, therefore all arbitration expenses including other expenses be met from the unspent amount of HEFA loan sanctioned for the construction of these buildings, and as such, the following proposal of University on the matter is approved:

- a) Appointment of legal counsel, having experience of the arbitration cases, directly by the University.
- b) Release of separate work order to EIL for providing the technical support for Rs. 40,056/- plus GST per man-day.
- c) All the administrative, technical and legal expenses w.r.t. this ongoing arbitration case be met from the HEFA loan sanctioned for the above projects.

The Committee further resolved unanimously that a letter be



	written to the Ministry concerned with the Engineers India Limited (EIL), the Project Management Consultant (PMC) for the construction of said projects at the Central University of Punjab, to instruct the EIL to defend our ongoing arbitration case.” In this regard, the University wrote a letter to Secretary, Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, GoI, vide No. CUPB/RO/2026-27/011 dated 04.05.2026. Response is awaited. It is important to mention here that dates of submitting the reply to the claims of arbitration were 02.05.2026 & 08.05.2026 for Phase 1A and 1B respectively, but due to pending consent of EIL for defending the arbitration, the process for seeking the extension of time for submission of reply is in process. If approved by Sole Arbitrator, these dates will be extended upto July 2026. The matter is placed before the Council to consider the recommendation of the Finance Committee.

The Central University of Punjab is currently disbursing the honorarium @ Rs. 3000/- per meeting and Rs. 5000/- (maximum ceiling) for more than one meeting(s) per day. <u>Item.No:EC:71:2026:37</u>	<u>AGENDA NOTE</u> M/s NBCC was appointed as a PMC for the work for construction of new buildings of phase-2, comprising one Academic Building, Girls Hostel (400 seater), Boys Hostel (600 seater), International Student Hostel (100 seater) & VC residence. The progress and quality of ongoing construction is being regularly monitored by various committees of the University such as Project Monitoring Committee, Sub-core Building Committee etc. As on 31.03.2026 the Physical progress was 45% and financial progress was 41%. The construction of buildings is 4 months ahead of its schedule as per MoU with NBCC. During the Project Monitoring Committee meeting held on 20.04.2026 following points related to construction of buildings entrusted to NBCC were discussed: 1. There is a provision of 06 lifts in the building, however, as per tender document and estimates only 04 lifts were considered. Executive Engineer of the University informed the Committee

	that the matter was considered by the Sub Core Building committee in its 1st meeting (Copy enclosed as Annexure-71.33) and they have recommended to install two additional lifts from the unspent balance of HEFA loan. The PMC considered the matter and was of the considered opinion that two additional lifts are essential requirements of building therefore, the approval for the installation of 02 additional lifts may be given to NBCC at the earliest after following due process of approval. 2. NBCC informed the Committee that as per tender/design in International Student hostel 1 Ton 5 Star hot and cold ACs were to be installed. However, due to change of guidelines in January 2026, 1Ton 5star Hot & Cold ACs are not available in market. Therefore, NBCC informed that they are going ahead with the provision of 1.5 Ton 3star Hot & Cold Invertor ACs of approved make, although they are costlier but the contractor will bear this additional cost due to non-availability of tender item. 3. NBCC also informed the Committee that as per the tender, the completion date of hostels is April, 2027, however, on the request of the University they will be handing over the hostels in August/September 2026. They further appraised the committee that as per tender document, there is a provision of GI door frames and GI windows in the hostels. On the balcony side, there is a DW (door window combined). There are very less manufacturers of GI window as this is not a regular item and the maintenance of this item will be a very tedious job in future. Therefore, considering the early handover of hostels, the contractor has submitted the request for use of UPVC sliding doors and windows with toughened glass on balcony side in hostels and UPVC windows in Academic building. NBCC further informed that UPVC is technically a better material and even costlier than GI door window. However, as the contractor has agreed to absorb the additional cost of UPVC windows. Therefore, NBCC informed the Committee that they are going ahead with the use of UPVC sliding doors with toughened glass as per CPWD DSR specifications in place of the GI door window in the balcony of the hostels and windows in Academic Building. The Minutes of Project Monitoring Committee are enclosed as Annexure-71.34. The following recommendations of Project Monitoring Committee are placed before the Executive Council: 1. Provision of 2 Nos of additional lifts may be allowed to be installed in New Academic Block and the amount be spent from Unspent HEFA loan sanctioned for the project.
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	2. The provision of 1.5 ton 3star inverter AC instead of 1 ton 5star AC in international student hostel may be allowed at no additional expenditure to the University. 3. Use of UPVC windows/sliding doors with toughened glass may be allowed instead of GI windows/ventilators/Door window at no additional cost to the University. 	The University after considering all the representations/request strictly as per the Guidelines for determining the Seniority of Teachers, circulated the final draft seniority of teachers (cadre-wise) vide Circular No. CUPB/Estt./2024/Circular/24 dated 09/12/2024. The said circular and Draft Seniority of Professors is placed at Annexure-71.45. A representation dated 11/12/2024 has been received from Prof. Anjana Munshi, Professor, Department of Human Genetics & Molecular Medicine regarding draft final seniority of Professors as circulated by the University (Annexure-71.46). The University referred the representation of Prof. Anjana Munshi to the same Committee as mentioned above for addressing her grievance. The meeting of the Committee was held on 19/03/2025. The Committee after discussion in detail in the light of guidelines for determining the Seniority of Teachers of the University observed that the seniority of Professors prepared and circulated by the University is in order. Accordingly, the Committee unanimously recommended that the representation of Prof. Anjana Munshi is not tenable; hence the same may not be acceded by the University (Annexure-71.47). The University again referred the representation of Prof. Munshi to the same Committee to revisit the case in order to protect seniority of teachers who join much earlier compared to junior ones. In the light of following, the Committee revisited the representation of Prof. Anjana Munshi, in detail: - (i) Statutes 24(1) of the CU Act, 2009 which states that ".....Whenever, in accordance with the Statutes, any person is to hold an office or be a member of an authority of the University by rotation according to seniority, such seniority shall be determined according to the length of continuous service of such person in his grade and in accordance with such other principles as the Executive Council may, from time to time, prescribe. (ii) Further, as per guidelines of the approved by Executive Council regarding the criteria for determining the seniority of Teachers of the CU Punjab, clause 2 states "..... "further provided that in case, the teacher is promoted as Associate Professor, Professor or Senior Professor under CAS first and subsequently joins against direct recruitment in the same cadre without any break in service at this University (CUP), then the length of service in the cadre will be considered from the date of promotion under CAS for determining
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	seniority.....” The Committee also noted that the contribution made by Prof. Anjana Munshi in the University are matter of records and do not have any impact on the policy/guidelines of Seniority of Teachers. Therefore, the Committee after detailed discussion observed that the seniority of Professor prepared and circulated by the University is in order and it is strictly in accordance with the criteria for determining the seniority of Teachers of Central University of Punjab, 2023 guidelines duly approved by the Executive Council. Accordingly, the Committee, after revisiting the representation of Prof. Anjana Munshi, unanimously recommended that her representation is not tenable; hence the same may not be acceded by the University. The recommendations of the Committee were placed in the Academic Council vide item No. Item.No:AC:32:2025:12 and Executive Council vide. Item.No:EC:64:2025:22. The resolve of the Executive Council is as under: <i>“The Council considered and unanimously resolved to approve the recommendation of the Academic Council that the external experts be included in the Committee to finalize the allied and relevant disciplines of the newly sanctioned departments/ centres/ programs for the purpose of recruitment of teachers. Further, the Council also resolved to authorize the Vice Chancellor to approve the recommendation of the Committee. Furthermore, the Council also resolved unanimously that for the purpose of screening, upto 50% candidates out of 25 for any advertised position will be from concerned subject group, and remaining 50% from the relevant/allied subject group put together, subject to availability of sufficient number of eligible candidates from either group. To further clarify, it is resolved that if 50% of eligible candidates out of 25 are not available either from concerned subject or relevant/allied subjects, the shortfall can be met from either of the two groups. This resolution shall be applicable only for filling of faculty positions for newly sanctioned departments/centres excepting for ITEP faculty in the Department of Education. Further, the two external members of EC namely Prof. KRS Sambasiva Rao and Prof. Manoj Dixit being subject experts in Biotechnology and Public Policy & Governance, respectively, have approved the allied and relevant subjects of these two disciplines. The experts from remaining subjects be invited for finalizing concerned/allied/relevant subjects.</i> In compliance, the Committees were constituted and the recommendations of the Committee were approved. Accordingly, the University vide Advt. No. CUPB/25-26/008 dated 10.11.2025 advertised the regular faculty positions, and shortlisting of candidates was done to hold the selection committees. The interviews in the Department of Community Medicine and Health were held on 17th and 18th April 2026 at CU Punjab, Bathinda. It is important to mention that the University while advertising the positions in the said department also notified the following

The copy of the communication was also sent by him to two other experts. Another expert also sent similar observations with regard to the eligibility criteria, qualification and nomenclature for the department of Community Medicine and Health but did not opt out from the Selection Committee. Moreover, this expert gave scores to all the candidates appeared for interview on the date of interview itself i.e. on 18.4.2026, and signed the proceedings of the selection committee along with the third expert. Clause 5.1(I) (b) of UGC Guidelines, on the composition of Selection Committee stipulates that <i>Four members, including two outside subject experts, shall constitute the quorum</i>. Accordingly, the quorum of the Selection Committee for appointment of Assistant Professors in the Department of Community Medicine and Health was complete. The Council was further apprised that prior to the aforesaid Selection Committee meeting, another Selection Committee for the post of Associate Professor under the same Department had been convened on 17.04.2026, wherein no objection whatsoever was raised by any member of the Committee with regard to either the eligibility criteria or the nomenclature of the Department. Accordingly, recommendation of this Selection Committee were finalized on the day of interview itself. The University apprised the Council that the University had followed all prescribed procedures and norms in a transparent and consistent manner right from the inception of the recruitment process. Prior to issuance of the advertisement, the University also constituted a Committee comprising one external expert for preparing eligibility criteria for faculty positions in newly sanctioned department of Community Medicine and Health and to recommend concerned, relevant and allied subjects for the purpose of recruitment of faculty in this department and the same were subsequently approved. From time to time, the University has obtained statutory approvals in this regard. It is pertinent to mention here that the Department of Community Medicine and Health has been approved/sanctioned vide MoE vide letter F.NO. 50-4/2023- CU.IV/CU.III dated 21.07.2023 along with approval regarding sanction of other new Departments/ Centres/ Programme, and teaching posts. Further, the nomenclature of the department, and the eligibility criteria for the advertised positions had been determined after extensive deliberations at the appropriate academic and administrative levels, keeping in view the nature of the discipline, UGC norms, prevailing practices in higher educational institutions, and the academic requirements of the University.

<u>Item.No:EC:71:2026:TA:42(XI)</u>	<u>AGENDA NOTE</u> It has been observed that various service-related disputes concerning employees of the University arise from time to time. Such disputes, if not addressed through an appropriate statutory mechanism, may remain pending for prolonged periods and could result in avoidable litigation, administrative complications, and financial implications for the University. To handle this issue, the Central Universities Act 2009 provides to refer the dispute arising out to a Tribunal of Arbitration. The clause no. 33 of the Central Universities Act, 2009 provides that: <i>"(1) Every employee of the University shall be appointed under a written contract, which shall be lodged with the University and a copy of which shall be furnished to the employee concerned.</i> <i>(2) Any dispute arising out of the contract between the University and any employee shall, at the request of the employee, be referred to a Tribunal of Arbitration consisting of one member appointed by the Executive Council, one member nominated by the employee concerned and an umpire appointed by the Visitor.</i> <i>(3) The decision of the Tribunal shall be final and no suit shall lie in any civil court in respect of the matters decided by the Tribunal: Provided that nothing in this subsection shall preclude the employee from availing of the judicial remedies available under articles 32 and 226 of the Constitution."</i> As per the provisions, the Tribunal of Arbitration shall consist of: • One member appointed by the Executive Council, • One member nominated by the concerned employee, and • An Umpire appointed by the Visitor.					



	In view of the above provisions, the Executive Council may nominate a member to the Tribunal of Arbitration so that the University may proceed further. The matter is placed before the Council for consideration.
<u>RESOLVE</u>	The Council, after detailed deliberations, unanimously resolved that the draft Ordinance pertaining to the Tribunal of Arbitration be prepared and submitted to the Ministry of Education for placing the same before the Hon'ble Visitor of the University for consideration and approval. Further, the Council authorized the Vice Chancellor to approve the draft Ordinance in this regard prior to its submission to the Ministry of Education. The Council also resolved unanimously that the matter regarding nomination of a member to be appointed by the Executive Council be placed before the Council after approval of the Ordinance by the Hon'ble Visitor.
