Procedure for Admission

1. Online Application:

Interested candidates must fill the online application form available at:

2. Date of Opening the Form:

01.09.2025

3. Closing Date of Form:

08.09.2025 or till the vacant seats are filled (whichever is earlier).

4. Counselling Fee (Non-refundable):

- ₹1000 for UR/OBC/EWS candidates
- ₹500 for SC/ST/PwD candidates

5. Reporting:

After filling the application form, candidates must physically report to:

Central University of Punjab, VPO-Ghudda, Bathinda – 151401

on any working day **up to 08.09.2025** or until seats are available, whichever is earlier.

6. Daily Merit List:

Merit list will be prepared only for candidates physically present for admission on that day. Merit will be prepared as per the **University's reservation roster**.

7. Documents Required:

- Copy of Admission Registration Form
- NCET-UG- 2025 Score Card
- Consolidated Mark Sheet/Result of Qualifying Examination/Degree
- All original documents with two sets of self-attested photocopies

8. Eligibility:

As per the eligibility criteria mentioned in the UG Prospectus available on the University website.

9. Reservation:

As per GoI guidelines.

10. Admission Fee:

Selected candidates must deposit the admission fee on the same day. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.

11. Candidate's Responsibility:

Ensuring eligibility is the sole responsibility of the candidate. If found ineligible at any stage, admission will be cancelled without refund of fee.

12. Seat Availability:

Admission is strictly subject to availability of seats on the day of counselling.

13. University Rights:

The University reserves the right to change the number of seats or modify admission conditions at any stage.
