To consider the recommendations of 27th meeting of the Academic Council held on 13th-14th July, 2023, w.r.t the School Board of Engineering and Technology.

AGENDA NOTE:

The Meeting of School Board, School of Engineering and Technology, was held on 10.07.2023.

The following recommendations were made by School Board for the department under the School:

1. The Curriculum Scheme/Syllabus M.Tech CST as proposed by the BoS, CST was deliberated and was approved after incorporating the suggestion made by the members of School Board, Engineering and Technology.
2. The Curriculum Scheme/ Syllabus of M.Tech CSE(Cyber Security) as proposed by the BoS, CST was deliberated and was approved after incorporating the suggestion made by the members of School Board, Engineering and Technology.
3. The list of visiting faculty proposed by the BOS was deliberated and the revised Approved list is attached.
4. The list of examiner for Dissertation proposed by the BOS was deliberated and the revised Approved list is attached.
5. The School Board approved the resolution of Board of studies to identify/Concerned/ relevant/ allied subject for Master's degree as per Clause 4 of UGC Regulations 2018. The list proposed by the BOS was deliberated and it was decided that the AICTE regulation in-force in this regard may be adhered to.
6. School Board approved the recommendation of Board of Studies CST for adoption of UGC guidelines for Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit, as follows:

As per UGC 2021 guidelines, there shall be one exit point for those students who join two years Master's programme, that is, at the end of the first year of Master's programme. The students who exit after the first year shall be awarded Post-Graduate Diploma (P.G. Diploma).

Therefore, School Board recommended the BoS proposal that the following P.G. Diplomas for those who exit after successful completion of first year (two semesters) of the concerned two years Master's degree programmes offered in the Department of Computer Science and Technology.

- i. **Post-Graduate Diploma in Computer Science and Technology:** For the candidates who join the two-year Master's programme in M.Tech Computer Science and Technology and leave after completion of one year.

Post-Graduate Diploma in Cyber Security: For the candidates who join the two-year Master’s programme in M.Tech Computer Science and Engineering (Cyber Security) and leave after completion of one year.</p> <p>For the exit scheme, the candidate has to complete any one course/task mentioned below along with his/her courses read in the first year of his/her Masters’ programme.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Students will have to opt a 4 credit course out of skill- based and vocational courses (4 credits) relevant to the programme, a basket of all such courses will be available to the students who opt to exit the programme.
